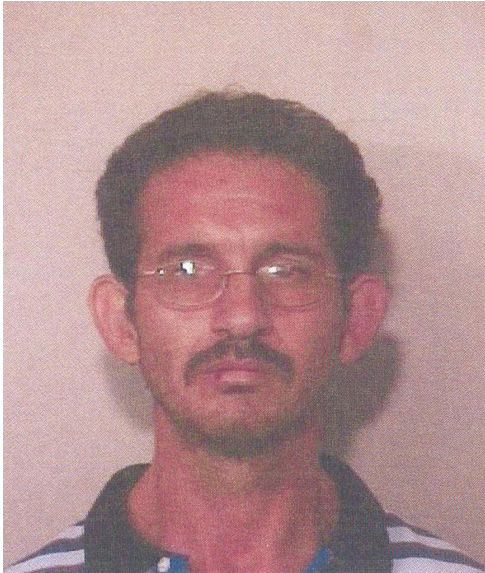

WHAT: Reynaldo Diaz Wanted For Interference with Child Custody



Crime Stoppers and its Law Enforcement Partners are seeking the public's assistance in locating Reynaldo Diaz.

In 2005, the 246th Family Court granted Reynaldo Diaz's wife full custody of their 4 year old daughter and Diaz was granted visitation. Diaz picked up his daughter on May 29, 2007 for his scheduled visit. He failed to return his daughter to her mother on Sunday June 3, 2007 as ordered by the Court. Since May 29, 2007, no one has seen or heard from Reynaldo Diaz and no one has seen his daughter. Diaz has since quit his job and sold his house and possibly moved to Mexico.

On July 2, 2007, criminal charges of Interference with Child Custody were filed on Reynaldo Diaz. The 351st District Court issued warrant 1123517 for his arrest. Diaz has a history of family violence.

Diaz is a 40 year Hispanic male. He is 5'06" tall and weighs 140 pounds. He has brown eyes and black hair with a skinny build. Attached is his photo.
