

## WHO KILLED EDWARD PICKNEY? UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

## FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT(S) IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Homicide Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect(s) responsible for a Murder.

On Sunday, June 30, 2019, at approximately 1:40 a.m., Edward Pickney was shot inside of his parked vehicle in the 6600 block of Cullen Boulevard in Houston, Texas. Witnesses heard a single gunshot and observed two males in ghost masks inside the victim's vehicle. The suspects fled in an unknown direction of travel. The victim died from a single gunshot wound to his torso.

The family of Edward Pickney is requesting the community's help with identifying the suspect(s) responsible for his murder.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the charging and/or arrest of the suspect(s) in this case.
