UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Vehicular Crimes Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect responsible for a Hit and Run – Failure to Stop and Render Aid.

On Monday, September 26, 2019, at approximately 1:19 a.m. The victim was riding a bicycle across the intersection in the 10200 block of Shady Lane in Houston, Texas. The suspect's vehicle (a gray Nissan Altima) was traveling southbound in the 10200 block of Shady Lane. The suspect's vehicle approached the stop sign, failing to yield the right of way and struck the victim. The suspect stopped and exited their vehicle and spoke briefly to the victim. The suspect then fled the scene without rendering aid to the victim. As a result, the victim suffered minor bodily injuries.

Suspect: Black male, mid 30's, approximately 6'2" with black hair.
