# **WANTED FOR A HIT & RUN FAILURE TO STOP AND RENDER AID UP TO \$5,000 REWARD**

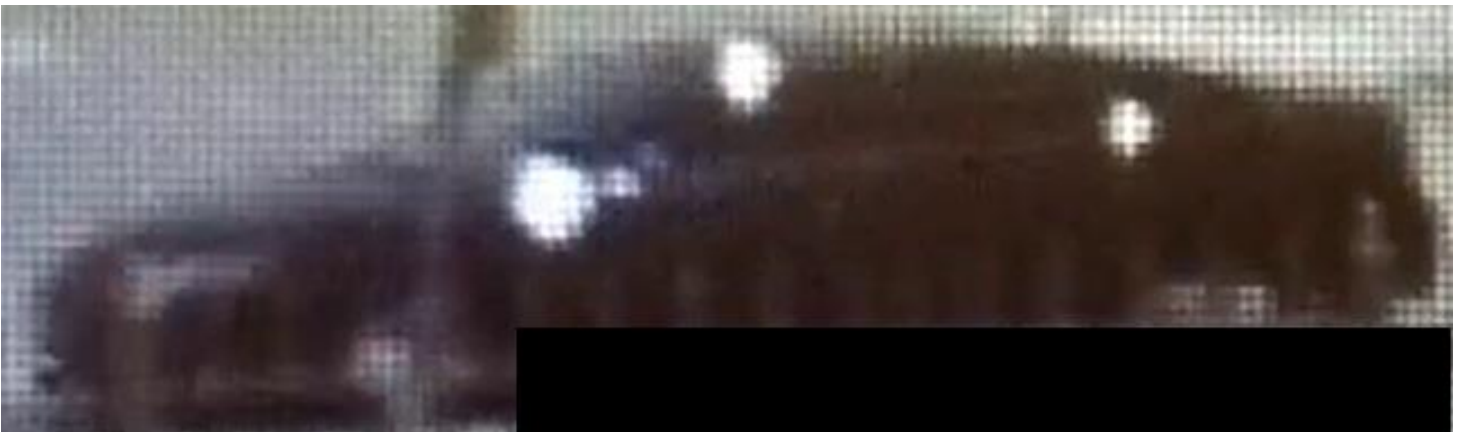
## **FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE**

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Vehicular Crimes Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect responsible for a Hit and Run – Failure to Stop and Render Aid.

On Wednesday, June 17, 2020, at approximately 12:33 p.m., the victim was riding a bicycle in the 4500 block of Reed Road in Houston, Texas. The suspect's vehicle (appearing to be a black Nissan sedan) struck the victim as it traveled west on Reed Road. The suspect fled the scene without rendering aid to the victim. As a result of the collision, the victim sustained serious bodily injuries and severe head trauma. The victim was taken to a local hospital for treatment.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the identification, charging and/or arrest of the suspect in this case.
