WANTED FOR A HIT & RUN FAILURE TO STOP AND RENDER AID

UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Vehicular Crimes Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect responsible for a Hit and Run – Failure to Stop and Render Aid.

On Tuesday, August 4, 2020, at approximately 1:00 a.m., the victim was riding his motorcycle in the 5100 block of South Shaver Street in Houston, Texas. The suspect's vehicle (dark colored pick-up truck) struck the victim from behind as the victim was about to turn onto Wald Road. The suspect fled the scene without rendering aid to the victim. As a result of the collision, the victim was taken to a local hospital where his leg had to be amputated.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the identification, charging and/or arrest of the suspect in this case.
