

WANTED FOR FORGERY UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Harris County Sheriff's Office Parks Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspects responsible for Forgery.

On June 26, 2020, at approximately 6:30 p.m., the victim's credit/debit cards and personal identification were stolen in the 6000 Block of E. Sam Houston Parkway N. in Harris County, Texas. On July 8, 2020, at approximately 4:45 p.m., two unknown female suspects presented the victim's identification and checking account information in an attempt to withdraw cash at a bank in the 11000 Block of Monroe Blvd. in Houston, Texas. During the incident, the suspects were captured on video surveillance conducting the transaction at a drive through teller lane. The suspects were driving a black 4-door Mazda.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the identification, charging and/or arrest of the suspects in this case.
