

WHO KILLED LAYVON SUELL? UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Homicide Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect(s) responsible for a Murder.

On Saturday, January 9, 2021, at approximately 2:45 a.m., Layvon Suell was walking in the 1100 block of Mclhenny Street in Houston, Texas. An unknown suspect began firing at towards Layvon striking him. Layvon Suell died as a result of the gunshot injuries he sustained during the shooting.

The family of Layvon Suell is requesting the community's help with identifying the suspect(s) responsible for his murder.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the identification, charging and/or arrest of the suspect in this case.
