

## WANTED FOR A HIT & RUN FAILURE TO STOP AND RENDER AID UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

## FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Vehicular Crimes Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect responsible for a Hit and Run – Failure to Stop and Render Aid.

On Friday, January 7, 2022, at approximately 6:43 a.m., the victim was walking in the 8500 block of Fuqua St. in Houston, Texas. During the incident, the victim was walking eastbound crossing the street in the 10500 block Moers Rd. when the suspect vehicle (2015-2020 black Dodge Ram, chrome features), which was traveling eastbound in the 8500 block of Fuqua St. struck the victim. The suspect fled the scene without rendering aid to the victim. The victim suffered serious bodily injury and was taken to a local hospital for treatment.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the charging and/or arrest of the suspect in this case.
