WHO KILLED ELIZABETH BARRAZA?

UP TO \$50,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Harris County Sheriff's Office Homicide Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect responsible for a Murder.

On Friday, January 25, 2019, at approximately 6:55 a.m., Elizabeth Barraza was shot multiple times in the 8600 block of Cedar Walk Dr. in Harris County, Texas. During the incident, the victim was approached by an unknown suspect (possibly female) in her driveway while preparing for a garage sale. The suspect shot the victim multiple times and fled in a dark colored Nissan Frontier pickup truck. The victim died as a result of the injuries they sustained during the incident.

The family of Elizabeth Barraza is requesting the community's help with identifying the suspect responsible for this murder.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$50,000 for information leading to the charging and/or arrest of the suspect in this case.
