WANTED FOR A HIT & RUN FAILURE TO STOP AND RENDER AID

UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT(S) IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Vehicular Crimes Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect(s) responsible for a Hit and Run – Failure to Stop and Render Aid.

On Sunday, July 23, 2023, at approximately 8:55 p.m., the victim was struck by a vehicle in the 2000 block of Westheimer Rd. in Houston, Texas. During the incident, the victim was on their motorcycle when they were struck from behind by the suspect's vehicle, a (red Ford F-150 newer model) which was traveling southbound on S. Shepherd. The suspect(s) fled the scene without rendering aid to the victim. The victim suffered major injuries and was taken to a local hospital for treatment.

The suspect's vehicle is described as a red Ford F-150 newer model (no license plate information).

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the charging and/or arrest of the suspect(s) in this case.
