WHO KILLED CHRISTOPHER MENA?

UP TO \$15,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING AND/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT IN THIS CASE

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department's Homicide Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect responsible for a Murder.

On Saturday, November 14, 2020, at approximately 6:15 a.m., Christopher Mena's body was found in the 9200 block of Cullen Blvd. in Houston, Texas. Officers were dispatched to a person down call and found the victim unresponsive inside his vehicle at the location. The victim had sustained a gunshot wound to the head and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The family of Christopher Mena is requesting the community's help with identifying the suspect responsible for his murder.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$15,000 for information leading to the identification, charging and/or arrest of the suspect in this case.
