WHO KILLED LAZARO NOA GARCIA? UP TO \$5,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE CHARGING &/OR ARREST OF THE SUSPECT(S) IN THIS CASE

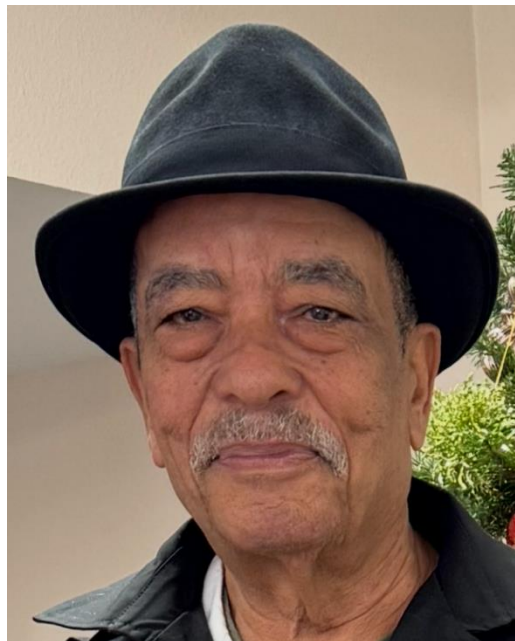
Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department Vehicular Crimes Division need the public's assistance identifying the suspect(s) responsible for a Hit and Run – Failure to Stop and Render Aid – Fatality.

On Friday, January 2, 2026, at approximately 6:00 p.m., the victim was crossing the street from east to west in the 2900 block of Broadway Street in Houston, Texas, when struck by the suspect's vehicle, described as a black SUV. The suspect fled the scene without rendering aid. Tragically, the victim succumbed to the severe injuries sustained in the incident.

The family of Lazaro Noa Garcia is requesting the community's help with identifying the suspect(s) responsible for this Hit and Run – Failure to Stop and Render Aid – Fatality.

Crime Stoppers may pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the charging &/or arrest of the suspect(s) in this case.
