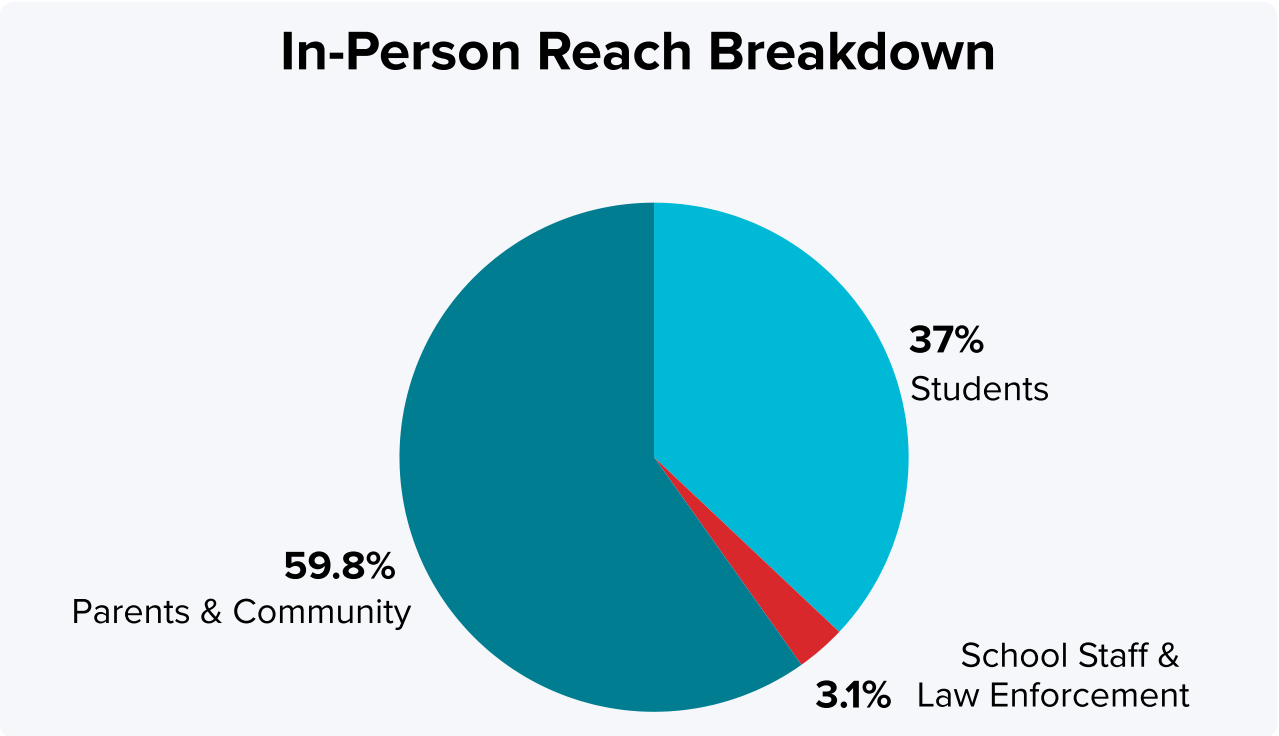

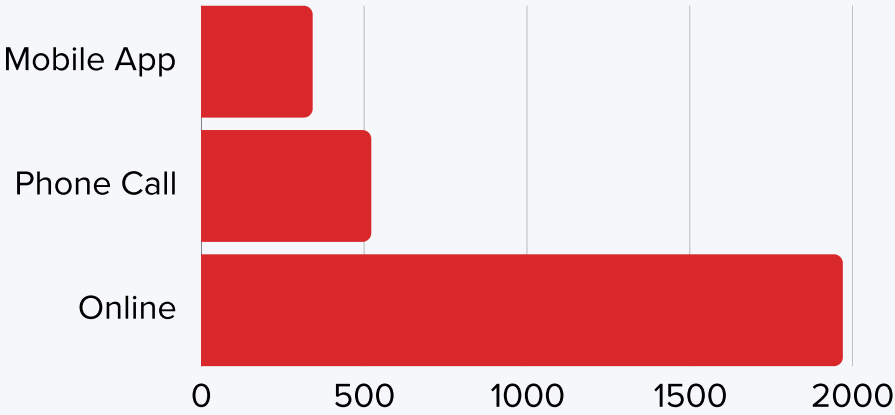

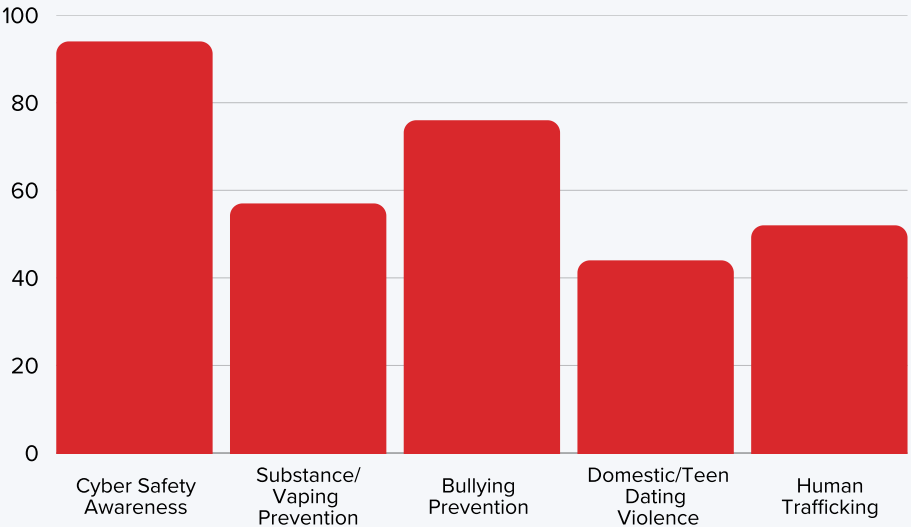

SafeSpace: Expanding Prevention Beyond the Classroom

Built for students ages 13-18, SafeSpace provides **24/7 access to trusted safety guidance, real-world scenarios, and practical tools** that help young people make safer decisions when it matters most. Developed as a digital extension of the Safe School Institute, the platform strengthens situational awareness and decision-making through interactive challenges, student-driven content, and clear guidance for navigating difficult situations.

Created in response to students' need for a trusted place to turn when challenges arise beyond the school day, SafeSpace expands access to Crime Stoppers of Houston's life-saving resources and represents an important step forward in delivering innovative prevention tools for the next generation.

Victim Resource Hub: Expanding Support for Victims and Families

The Texas Victims' Rights and Support Hub, launched in March 2026, provides clear guidance on victims' rights at each stage of the criminal justice process while connecting users to verified service providers across Texas. By bringing critical information and resources into one accessible location, the platform reduces confusion and helps ensure victims have reliable support when navigating complex and often overwhelming circumstances.
