CRIME STOPPERS OF HOUSTON STUDENT PRESENTATIONS

These presentations promote personal safety to aid students in avoiding victimization and deterring delinquency and emphasize the importance of reporting dangers and criminal activity on campus.

ACTIVE SHOOTER AWARENESS | 45 MIN

Active shooter threats in America have reached deeply troubling levels. This presentation provides practical strategies for survival and rapid response. Topics include response options, medical considerations, and ways to enhance situational awareness in any environment.

be nice[®] (MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS)

For all ages, through a four-part action plan, students are taught to notice those around them, invite change and conversation, challenge themselves and others to get help and be empowered to take action. Elementary students learn how to utilize the action plan by reading books “One” and “Zero” by Kathryn Otoshi. These books reinforce mental health best practices and effective communication. Middle and High School students learn how to recognize signs and symptoms of depression and anxiety while destigmatizing mental illness.

BULLYING PREVENTION

For elementary students, this presentation introduces the concepts of bullying, conflict, consequences, and resolution strategies—reinforced through relatable scenarios.

For middle and high school students, it explores types of bullying, the impact of the internet, David’s Law, and available reporting tools. Students learn how to access campus resources and the importance of being an upstander, not a bystander.

CYBER SAFETY AWARENESS

This presentation teaches elementary students how to respond to inappropriate content, protect personal information, and recognize cyberbullying. Tweens and teens will learn how to stay safe online, address cyberbullying effectively, and build a positive digital presence and community.

DATING SAFETY & SEXUAL MISCONDUCT AWARENESS

This presentation helps students understand teen dating violence by defining it and highlighting different forms of victimization. They’ll learn to recognize the signs of healthy vs. unhealthy relationships, spot red flags early, and understand their rights through relevant laws and policies—empowering them to make informed, respectful choices.

FENTANYL AWARENESS

Fentanyl-related poisonings have become a critical public health issue, especially among students. This presentation addresses mental health best practices, adolescent substance use and addiction, and highlights community resources for support and prevention.

This presentation defines human trafficking, shares key statistics, and sheds light on where and how it happens—including the tactics traffickers use to target students. JUVENILE LAW AWARENESS

Teens often seek clarity on laws and consequences tied to real-life situations. This presentation highlights key legal topics including cyber safety, bullying, terroristic threats, privacy rights, the law of parties, consent, human trafficking, and substance use—empowering students with knowledge to make informed decisions and understand accountability.

MORE THAN YES: CONSENT AWARENESS

Consent is rooted in clear communication, mutual agreement, and respect for personal boundaries. This presentation will help students understand what consent is and what it is not, while highlighting the importance of communication, trust, relevant laws, and the resources that support safety and respect.

PROM SAFETY AWARENESS

This presentation explores the origins of prom and covers key topics like healthy relationships, setting boundaries, consent, underage drinking, drug use, and their consequences. It also offers practical tips to help students and their friends stay safe and make smart choices on prom night.

RISE OF TECHNOLOGY: AI AWARENESS

AI is part of daily life, from voice assistants to online recommendations. While it offers convenience and new opportunities, it also poses risks if misused. SUBSTANCE USE PREVENTION

This presentation explains how drug and alcohol use during adolescence can critically impact brain development into adulthood. SOCIAL MEDIA & MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS

Active shooter threats in America have reached deeply troubling levels. This presentation provides practical strategies for survival and rapid response. Topics include response options, medical considerations, and ways to enhance situational awareness in any environment.



(MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS) | 45 MIN

Educators are often the first to notice changes in a student's behavior. This presentation equips school staff with the tools to recognize signs of mental illness—especially depression and anxiety—and understand the growing impact of suicide and bullying among youth. Using a four-part action plan, staff will learn how to notice those around them, invite change, challenge kindness, and empower action, fostering a supportive and responsive school environment.

BULLYING PREVENTION | 60 MIN

This training provides best practices for fostering a bully-free school climate. Staff will learn to identify different types of bullying, understand the impact of online behavior, review key statistics and state laws, and explore effective strategies to support students both on and off campus.

CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION: RECOGNIZING & REPORTING | 60-90 MIN

***TEA APPROVED VENDOR**

This training equips school staff to recognize signs and symptoms of all forms of child abuse, including neglect and human trafficking. It reviews current laws and outlines best practices for handling disclosures, emphasizing staff responsibilities and required reporting procedures. Resources are provided to support appropriate and effective responses.

CYBER SAFETY AWARENESS | 60 MIN

This presentation provides an in-depth look at cyber safety and online victimization. Staff will explore current digital threats, emerging trends, hidden features in popular social media apps, and an overview of gaming platforms. It also covers long-term consequences, relevant laws, and monitoring tools to help keep students safe while using technology—both in and out of the classroom.

DATING SAFETY & SEXUAL MISCONDUCT AWARENESS | 60 MIN

This presentation equips staff to support students by outlining relationship types, the importance of setting boundaries, and how to recognize signs of unhealthy behavior. It includes a clear definition of consent, proactive safety strategies, and guidance on when to involve Title IX or legal protections.

FENTANYL AWARENESS | 60 MIN

Fentanyl-related poisonings are a growing concern among students. This presentation equips educators with key insights into adolescent substance use, its link to mental health, and signs of addiction. Staff will learn best practices for student support, early intervention, and how to connect with community resources to promote prevention.

GAMING SAFETY AWARENESS | 60 MIN

The rise of online gaming in mainstream culture has caused an increased risk of vulnerability and victimization in students. This presentation introduces video game basics, the cultural impact of eSports, and how gaming may affect student behavior and safety. It concludes with tools and techniques to help monitor and support safe gameplay at home.

HATE & HARASSMENT AWARENESS | 60 MIN

Learn to identify bullying, threats, harassment, and hate crimes. This training covers key distinctions, real-life examples, legal responsibilities, and school policies. Gain practical strategies to prevent and respond—creating a safer, more inclusive school environment.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS | 60 MIN

***TEA APPROVED VENDOR**

This presentation dispels myths about school-aged trafficking and highlights how it affects students in every community. Learn what trafficking is, how youth are targeted, and how to spot academic, behavioral, and physical warning signs. The session also covers prevention strategies, reporting protocols, and best practices for school staff.

ONLINE SOLICITATION PREVENTION | 60 MIN

The internet plays a crucial role in human trafficking, and educators are on the front lines of prevention. This presentation explores how predators use social media, grooming, and sextortion to exploit students. CYBER SAFETY AWARENESS | 60 MIN

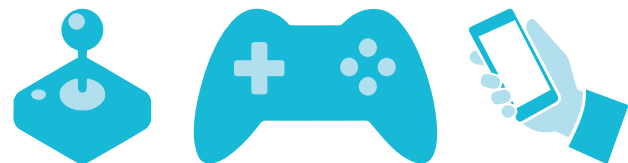

HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS | 45 MIN

There are many misconceptions regarding school-aged human trafficking. The reality is, human trafficking is happening in every neighborhood and does not discriminate. This presentation clarifies what human trafficking is, where it happens, how youth are lured in, exposes traffickers, and provides prevention strategies. We discuss the academic, behavioral, and physical signs of youth trafficking victims, as well as reporting protocols and best practices.

MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS | 45 MIN

This presentation introduces mental health and how it affects a child's emotions, decision-making, and relationships. Parents will learn about common mental health disorders, how to recognize symptoms, and potential treatment options. The session also offers strategies for maintaining positive mental health and supporting a child in crisis.
