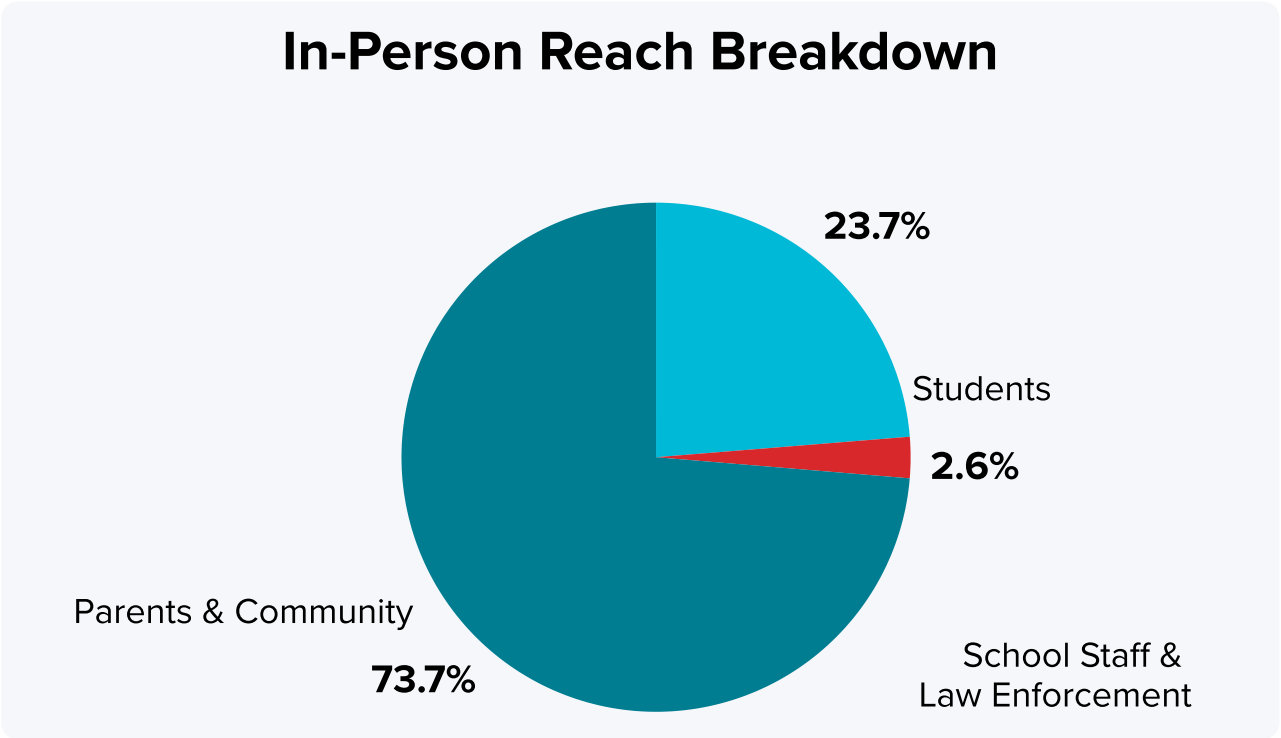

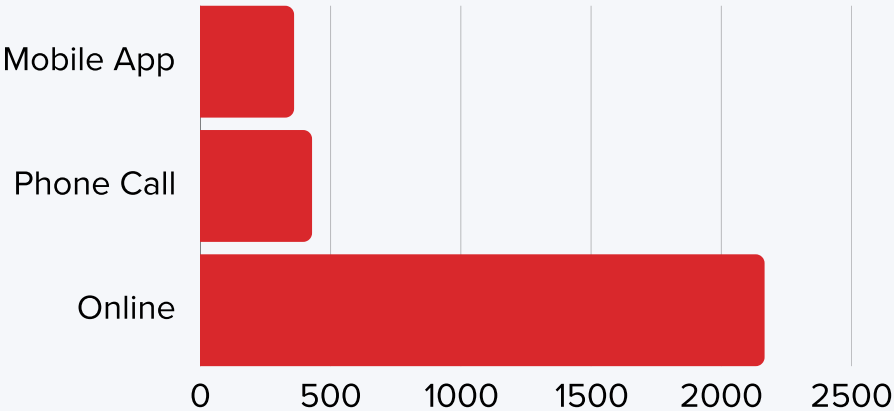

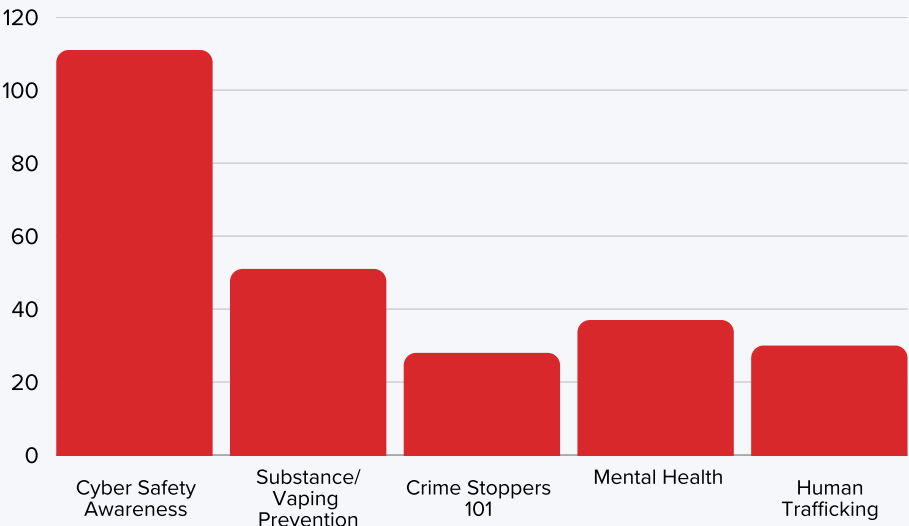

Q2 Major Achievements

Never Too Late for Justice - Lovers' Lane Arrest

After nearly 36 years, a new tip helped investigators identify and arrest the suspect responsible for the murders of Cheryl Henry, 22, and Andy Atkinson, 21.

When people feel empowered to come forward with information, no matter how much time has passed, families can finally receive the answers and justice they have long awaited. Cases like this demonstrate the critical role community members play in helping investigators uncover the truth and hold offenders accountable.

Not only did this information help bring justice to Cheryl and Andy, but it also encouraged other potential victims to come forward and have their stories heard. It serves as a powerful reminder that with tools like the Crime Stoppers of Houston Tip Line, it's never too late for justice.

The victims were last seen on August 22, 1990 at 10:40 p.m. at Bayou Mama's at Woodlake square. At 5:10 p.m. on August 23, 1990 the victims car was found by a security guard near the 1300 block of Enclave Parkway. Police were called to the scene, searched and found the victims bodies with their throats slashed in a field nearby.

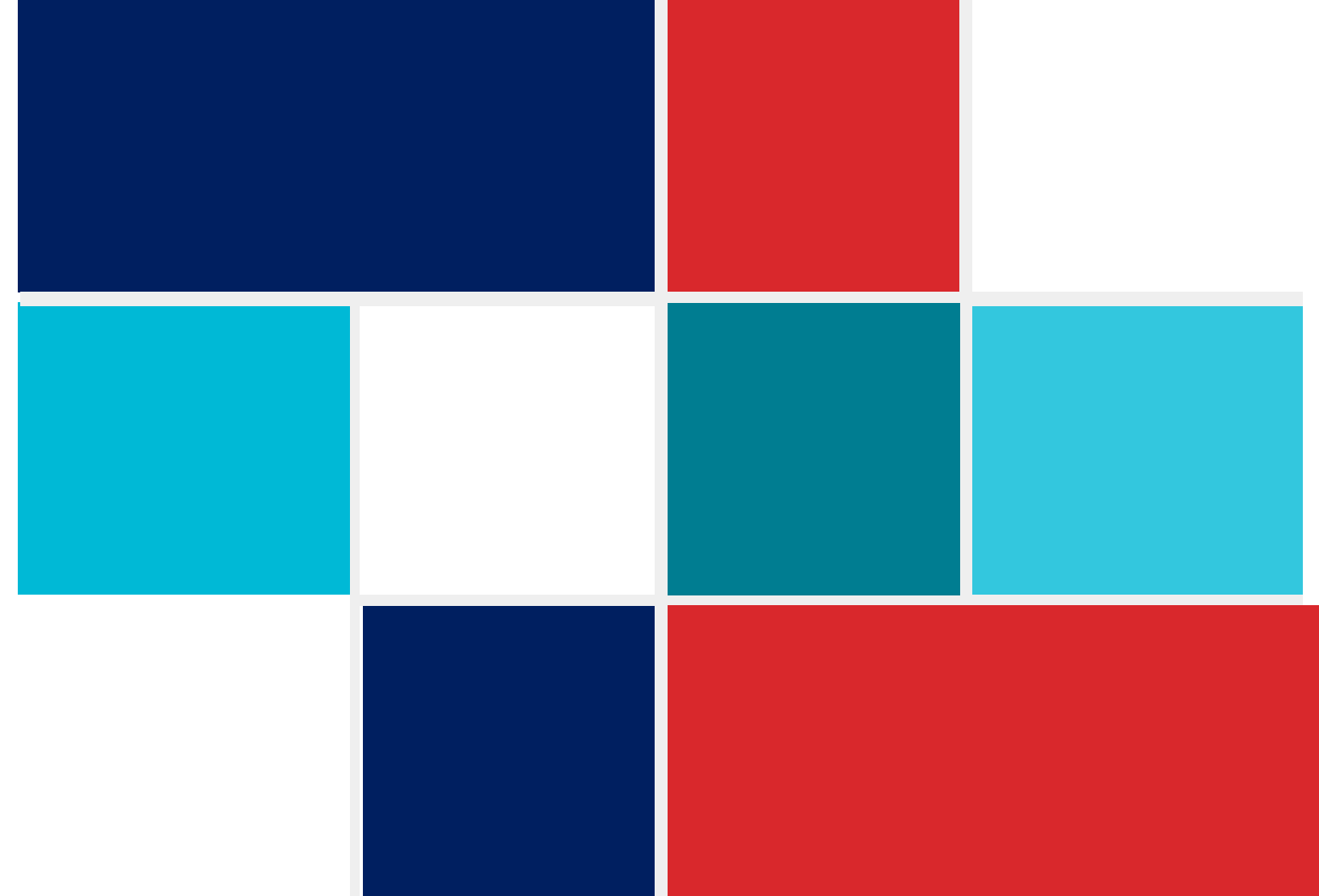
Safe School Institute
